LINC offers a Personal Assistant (PA) Referral Service for people with disabilities who need assistance at home with activities of daily living.

- LINC assists in finding a PA: recruiting, hiring, background checks, and training, if needed.
- LINC can provide PA Management Skills Training if needed.
- The Personal Assistant Coordinator can help with questions regarding PA paperwork, including service plans, and how to effectively use the hours provided by the Department of Rehabilitation Services.
- LINC offers training to the PA's on our referral list. Individual training can also be provided about specific disabilities or areas of care.
- Personal Assistants referred by LINC are required to have background checks done (from the county they live in) and attend a personal assistant orientation.

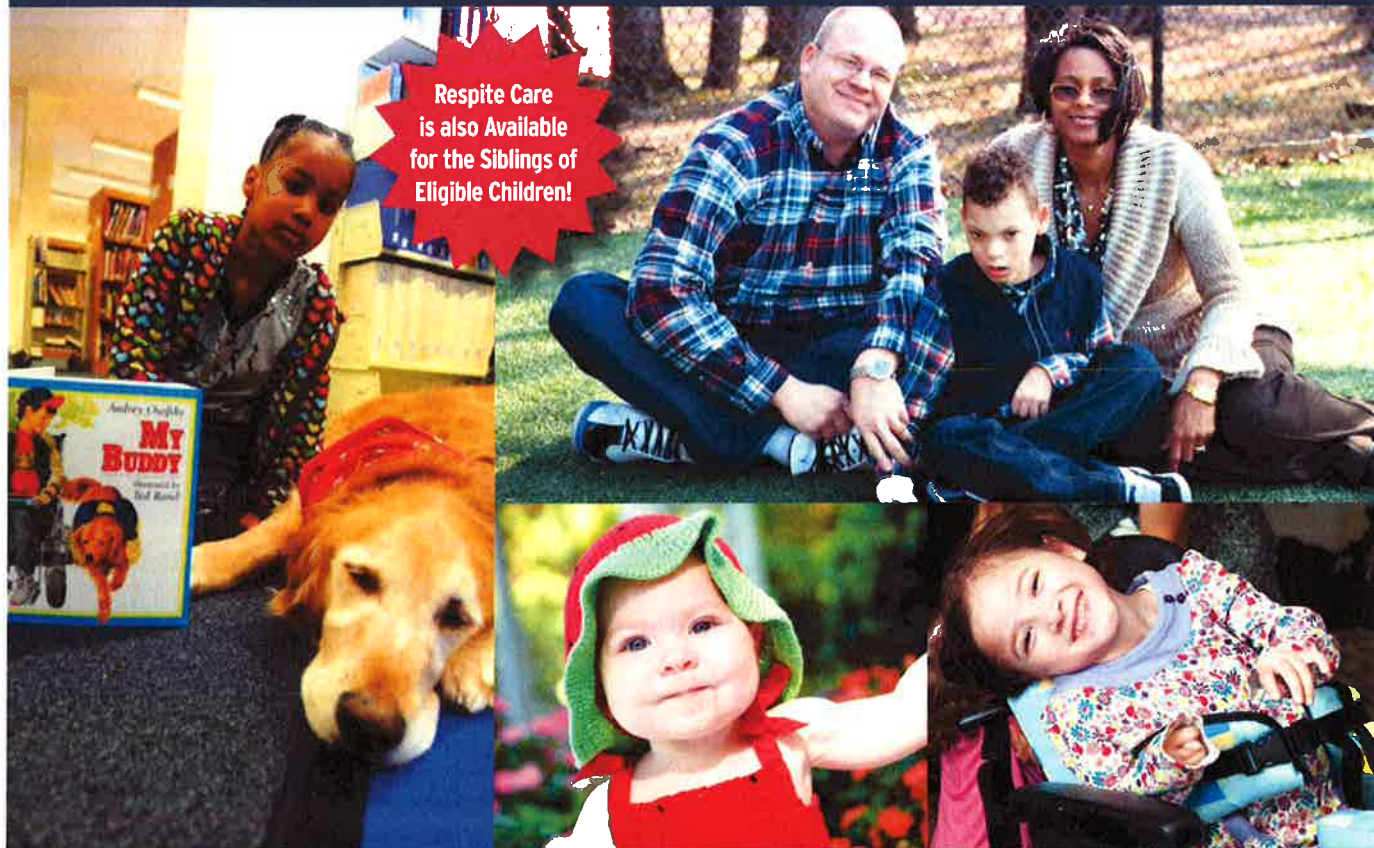

HOW DO I KNOW IF I AM ELIGIBLE?

- ▶ The family member is enrolled in the Air Force Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP)
- ▶ The EFM child is age birth through 18
- ▶ The EFM child has severe or moderate special needs
- ▶ The EFM child's sibling is age birth through 12

Check the website to see where the program is available.

No income restrictions - FREE to eligible Air Force families.
